Potatoes for propagation must be free from *Synchytrium endibioticum*, *Globodera rostochiensis*, *Leptinotarsa decemlineata* (Colorado potato beetle), and substantially free from adhering soil and other contaminations. Also must be substantially free from dangerous diseases, particularly virus diseases.

Packing material must be clean and in good condition.
