Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required for all hosts of Mediterranean fruit fly & Oriental fruit fly.

AD Required:

“The commodity in this shipment originated in an area within (county name) county of California which is not regulated for harmful species of fruit flies. Further, the commodity was subsequently safeguarded from exposure to harmful fruit flies.”

NOTE: The usual procedures inherent in the operation of quarantine regulated areas are sufficient to satisfy the safeguarding portion of the AD.

NOTE: Split shipments (for example, a consignment that consists of more than one container, and for some reason the containers are shipped at different times) require a Phyto certificate for each separate shipment or it will be refused entry.

PLANTS (including cuttings), PLANT PARTS (except seed) –

Import Permit and State or Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required. State of origin must be indicated on the certificate.

SEEDS –

State or Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required. State of origin must be indicated on the certificate.

Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required. All host fruit & vegetables of Mediterranean and Oriental fruit fly require a Federal phyto.

AD Required:

“The commodity in this shipment originated in an area within (county name) county of California which is not regulated for harmful species of fruit flies. Further, the commodity was subsequently safeguarded from exposure to harmful fruit flies”.

NOTE: The usual procedures inherent in the operation of quarantine regulated areas are sufficient to satisfy the safeguarding portion of the AD.

An Import permit and Federal phyto is required for grapes from all other states of the continental USA (except CA & FL).
