Must be free from sand, soil, and earth. Packing materials must be new.

Fresh vegetables may be prohibited (embargoed) periodically depending upon local production. For current information on existing embargoes, contact the Government Marketing Centre, Bermuda, telephone: (809) 292-4356. Embargoed ag commodities arriving in Bermuda are subject to seizure by the Bermuda customs, and destruction (usually by burning) by the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries. Bermuda importers and the Bermuda Customs service receive the “Bermuda Fresh Products Forecasts” as they are issued. It is the importer’s responsibility to know these restrictions.

BOTANICAL NAME – *Citrus spp. & Rosa hybrida*

PRODUCT FORM – Seeds & Plants

PHYTO FORM – Fed

IMPORT PERMIT – Yes

RESTRICTIONS – Prohibited

SUMMARY INFO – (from CA) Import Permit & Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required. **DO NOT CERTIFY UNLESS AN IMPORT PERMIT IS PRESENTED AND ALL CONDITIONS CAN BE MET.**

Plants **MUST** be defoliated before arrival in Bermuda to eliminate *Aleurocanthus woglumi* (Citrus Blackfly). Must be free from *Globodera rostochinensis* (golden nematode) and *Radopholus similis* (burrowing nematode).

NOTE PER EXCERPT: If the Import Permit requires the following: “Plants must be free of all injurious pests and diseases,” **DO NOT CERTIFY THE SHIPMENT**, as it would require a 100% inspection resulting in the destruction of the plants.

SUBSIDIARY INFO –

Phyto inspections must take place within 30 days of shipping.
