APPROVED NAME - Israel

COMMODITY – Almonds, Black-eyed Peas /Beans, & Pistachios

BOTANICAL NAME – Prunus dulcis, Vigna unguiculata, & Pistachio vera

PRODUCT FORM – Nuts, Plants, Parts, Seed

PHYTO FORM – Fed

IMPORT PERMIT – No – Shelled Almonds

RESTRICTIONS -Restricted

Yes – In-shell Almonds, Pistachios,
& Black-eyed Peas/Beans

SUMMARY INFO - Note: for nuts - **“Shelled” or “In-Shell” MUST be written in the name of produce section (box9) on the phyto.**

Shelled Almonds –

Federal Phytosanitary Certificate required. All packing material must be new. Must be free of sand and soil.

In-shell Almonds, Shelled and In-shell Pistachios, Black-eyed Peas /Beans–

Import permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate required.

Note: All phytosanitary requirements may not be met if an Import Permit is not presented at the time of certification. Shipments NOT meeting Israel's phytosanitary requirements may experience delays and/or will be refused entry.

REVIEW THE IMPORT PERMIT: If an IP indicates a treatment is required, the treatment **MUST** be on the PC and **MUST** be monitored by an Authorized Certification Official (ACO). Any deviation must be authorized by Export Services.

IMPORTANT: All packing material must be new and shipment must be free of sand and soil.

Pistachios require either:

A Methyl Bromide treatment:
rate: 32g/m³,
temperature: 15C (59F) to
20C (68F),
duration: 24 hours.

Or

A Phosphine treatment
Rate: 1g/m³,
temperature: 15C (59F),
duration: 7 Days

All treatments must be witnessed by an ACO and details written on the Phyto.

Black-eyed Peas /Bean seed for propagation have the same requirements as listed above, but the contents must be identified on the outside of each container, bag, etc.

SUBSIDIARY INFO -

Phytosanitary inspection must be made within 30 days of shipping.

COMMODITY – Carrots, Citrus fruit, Grapes, Onions, & Garlic

BOTANICAL NAME – *Daucus carota*, *Citrus spp.*, *Vitis vinifera*, *Allium cepa*,
Allium sativum

PRODUCT FORM – Fruit & Vegetables

PHYTO FORM – Fed

IMPORT PERMIT – Yes

RESTRICTIONS - Restricted

SUMMARY INFO – (from CA)

All fresh fruit and vegetables including root crops (Except apples, pears, & potatoes):

Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate required. Must be free from soil and sand.

Note: Exporters should be warned that all phytosanitary requirements may not be met if an Import Permit is not presented at the time of certification. Shipments not meeting Israel's phytosanitary requirements may experience delays and/or will be refused entry.

COMMODITY – Citrus Plants, Citrus Seed, Citrus Trees, & Roses

BOTANICAL NAME – *Citrus spp.*, *Rosa spp.*

PRODUCT FORM – Nursery Stock, Plants, Parts, Seed PHYTO FORM – Fed

IMPORT PERMIT – Yes

RESTRICTIONS - Restricted

SUMMARY INFO -

CITRUS PLANTS, PLANT PARTS, TREES, (except seed) & ROSES –

Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate required.

OV Required: The place where the plants were taken (Produced) has been officially inspected in active growth during the last growing season.

Plants must be free from soil and sand. All packing materials must be new. Contents must be identified on the outside of each container.

CITRUS SEED –

Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate Required.

Contents of package must be identified on the outside of the package. Packing material must be new material. Product must be free from soil and sand. Growing season inspections may be required by the import permit for some types of seed.

Official phytosanitary inspection for the phyto certificate must occur within 30 days of shipment for seed.

Note: Exporters should be warned that all phytosanitary requirements may not be met if an Import Permit is not presented at the time of certification. Shipments not meeting Israel's phytosanitary requirements may experience delays and/or will be refused entry.

SUBSIDIARY INFO -

Phyto inspections must take place within 14 days of shipping for all propagative material (except seed).

COMMODITY – Cotton, Cotton Seed

BOTANICAL NAME – *Gossypium spp.*

PRODUCT FORM – Lint & Seed

PHYTO FORM – Fed

IMPORT PERMIT – No - Lint
Yes – Seed

RESTRICTIONS – Unrestricted - Lint
Prohibited – Seed

SUMMARY INFO – (from CA)

COTTON LINT –

Cotton lint is Unrestricted. You may issue a Federal Phyto upon request.

Please note: Cotton lint and cotton fiber are different. Most baled cotton is considered to be lint which is (3/4” long or longer) and free from seed and seed trash.

Cotton fiber is (3/16” and smaller) and is more likely to be contaminated with pieces of seed and seed trash. Fiber is a restricted product. It requires fumigation and an AD – call the Bakersfield office if you are asked to certify fiber.

COTTON SEED –

Import Permit and Federal Phytosanitary Certificate required. Cotton seed for propagation is prohibited. **DO NOT CERTIFY UNLESS AN IMPORT PERMIT IS PRESENTED.**

SUBSIDIARY INFO –

Phyto inspection must be made within 30 days of shipping.
