


Seedless Mandarin and Honey Bee Coexistence
Title 3, Division 3, Chapter 1, Subchapter 4, Sections 1430.54-1430.57

Pursuant to Sections 1430.54-1430.57 of Title 3 of the California Code of Regulations regarding seedless mandarin and honeybee coexistence, the Department of Food and Agriculture instructs county agricultural commissioners in the designated protection areas of Fresno, Kern, Tulare and Madera to provide a one month period for the registration of seedless mandarin acreage, commencing February 24, 2010 concluding on March 24, 2010. Sections 1430.55, subdivisions (a) -(c) require that registration of seedless mandarin acreage initially take place upon formal adoption of the regulations, February 24, 2010, with the registration period in subsequent years starting on January 1 and concluding on January 31.
