A-H will expire Dec. 31, 2018; 6 hrs. CEU will be needed for renewal

I-Q will expire Dec. 31, 2019; 6 hrs. CEU will be needed for renewal

**R-Z will expire Dec. 31, 2017; 6 hrs. CEU will be needed for renewal**

Those who do not meet the requirements outlined above must pass a written Department of Pesticide Regulation exam to renew their Private Applicator Certification (PAC). We hope that you are able to attend one of these informative sessions.
