


**SUPPLEMENTAL PERMIT CONDITIONS FOR  
GROUND WATER PROTECTION AREA MATERIALS**  
When used at non-production &/or non-agricultural sites.  
(non-site specific)

1. GWPA Materials (CCR 6800a: Atrozin, Simazine, Bromacil, Diuron, Prometon, Bentazon and Norflurazon) must be listed on a Restricted Materials Permit when they are used in a designated Ground Water Protection Area (GWPA).
2. A Notice of Intent (NOI) must be submitted to the Commissioner 24 hour prior to the application of a GWPA Material in a GWPA.

In addition to the regularly required information, the Notice of Intent (NOI) shall include:

- a. The specific location of the GWPA, by Section, Township, and Range, where the application is going to take place.
- b. What type of GWPA (leaching or runoff) the application is going to be made in.
- c. The NOI shall also include the specific management option being used for this application (one of the leaching or runoff management options listed on the permit).

 The use of 6800a materials is prohibited below the high water line inside unlined canals, ditch banks and artificial recharge basins, except under certain conditions. This restriction is statewide, not just in GWPA's. See CCR Sec. 6487.1-3 for details.

These supplemental conditions are intended for permittee's with non-site specific designations (uncultivated non-ag, water areas, landscape etc.) on their permit. These permittee's may include: Water Districts, Cal Trans, Railroads, Cities, Parks and Recreation Districts, Pest Control Businesses, etc.
